About Ms. Renee Todd:

Ms. Todd is currently in her eighth year as Director of Bands at Ligon GT Magnet Middle School and twenty-seventh year of teaching music. Under the direction of Ms. Todd, the Ligon Band program has grown to over 220 band members, with four wind bands and a jazz ensemble achieving superior ratings at both local and national music festivals. Ms. Todd and Ligon Bands will have a banner year as the Wind Ensemble will perform in the 29th Music For All National Concert Festival held in March of 2020 while the Jazz Ensemble performs at the prestigious 73rd Midwest Band and Orchestra Clinic in December 2019. Ms. Todd was honored in 2019 to receive the Award of Excellence by the Central District Band Directors Association. In 2018 she received Jazz Educator of the Year from the NC Central Region Jazz Educators and in 2016 awarded Band Director of the Year for the NC Central District.

In 1993, Ms. Todd received her Bachelor of Science in Music Education from the University of Maryland College Park, where she studied under John Wakefield, Emerson Head and L Richmond Sparks. While in college Ms. Todd was the drum major and trumpet section leader of the Mighty Sound of Maryland Marching Band and recipient of the Otto Sibenachen- Most Outstanding Musician in the top wind band at Maryland.

Before her appointment at Ligon, Ms. Todd was nominated Teacher Of The Year at both Dillard Drive Elementary and Wendell Middle Schools. She has served for site host for the NC Central District Band Music Performance Adjudication and Wake County Public School System All-County Band and served on the board for the Central District Band Association. Ms. Todd is a member of the National Association for Music Education, American School Band Directors Association, National Band Association, the North Carolina Music Educators Association, and Tau Beta Sigma.

As an active guest clinician and conductor, Ms. Todd has served or is scheduled as a clinician with several NC District Middle School Bands including the Northwest, Southeastern, and South Central All-District Bands. Ms. Todd has conducted several Junior Bands at UNCG Summer Music Camp, the Eastern, Central and Western Region Middle School Jazz Bands and the North Carolina Area Independent Schools Honor Band. She has served or is scheduled as a guest clinician for the Buncombe, Cleveland, Davidson, Durham, Johnston and Forsyth All-County, Bands. Ms. Todd is an active freelance trumpeter as well as a private instructor in the Triangle area

Jason Barclift graduated from East Carolina University with a Bachelors of Music in Music Education in 1998 and a Masters of Music in Music Education in 2006. He received his National Board Certification in Music for Early Adolescence through Young Adulthood in 2005 and renewed his certification in 2014. From 1998 – 2005 he taught at H. J. MacDonald Middle School in New Bern, NC, from 2005-2011 at E. B. Aycok Middle School in Greenville, NC, and from 2011-14 at Broad Creek Middle School in Newport, NC. He is currently serving as the band director at Morehead City Middle School where his Eighth Grade Band performed at the North Carolina Music Educators Association (NCMEA) Annual Professional Development Conference in November of 2016. Mr. Barclift holds memberships in the National Association for Music Educators (NAfME), North Carolina Music Educators Association (NCMEA), North Carolina Bandmasters Association (NCBA) and the American School Band Directors Association (ASBDA). Mr. Barclift has served the NCBA Eastern District as the Assistant All-District Auditions and Clinic Chair and Auditions host for many years. He served the Eastern District as President-Elect, President, and Immediate Past-President from 2009-2015. He was the North Carolina Bandmasters Association Secretary from 2014-2016 and is currently the President of the NCBA.

Mr. Barclift is an active clinician and judge. He has conducted various Honors Bands and adjudicated marching competitions and state band festivals in North Carolina and Virginia. Mr. Barclift, a native of Chesapeake, VA, now resides in Carteret County with his wife Kim, band director at Broad Creek Middle School, and their son Elijah, a French Horn player in the 9th grade at Coatan High School.

About Mr. Whit Blount:

Whit Blount has served as the band director at his alma mater, Myers Park High School in Charlotte, since 2006. Prior to his appointment at Myers Park, Mr. Blount was the band director at Alexander Graham Middle School from 2001-2006. He graduated from UNC-Chapel Hill with a Trumpet Performance degree in 2000 and a Masters of Arts in Teaching in 2001. During his time in Chapel Hill, Mr. Blount studied Trumpet with Mr. James Ketch, conducting with Dr. Michael Votta and Mr. Tonu Kalam, and student taught under the supervision of Dr. Jerome Markoch at Athens Drive High School. At Alexander Graham MS, the band program doubled in size under Mr. Blount's leadership, with the band director position growing from a half time to a full time position. At Myers Park, he supervises a comprehensive band program that includes an award-winning marching band, two concert bands, percussion ensemble, a jazz band and an AP Music Theory course. The bands at MP have earned many "superior" ratings, have been praised by adjudicators for their exuberance and passion in performance, and in 2018 and 2019 were invited to perform at the Blumenthal Performing Arts Center. Students from the bands earn chairs in the South Central District and All-State Honor Bands, as well as West Region and All-State Jazz Bands. Mr. Blount serves nationally on the Instructional Design Team for AP Music Theory, and was recently invited to serve on the Exam Development Committee. Mr. Blount is a member of Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, The North Carolina Bandmasters Association, The South Central District Bandmasters Association, The North Carolina Music Educators Association, and The National Association for Music Education. He continues play Trumpet in Charlotte, both professionally and as a member of several community ensembles, such as the Charlotte Concert Band. He has been married to his wife Danielle for 16 years. They currently reside in Charlotte with their sons, Ethan (14) and Austin (11).
