I have received an update from WC Lanning regarding this year's sightreading. Phillip Riggs will serve as our sightreading judge. Please carefully read the information below. Remember that for percussion needs, you are responsible for bringing any mallets and accessory instruments (including snare drum) called for. We will have mallet instruments, timpani and bass drum in the sightreading room but <u>will not</u> be asking Wingate University to borrow anything else, including mallets for the instruments provided.

There will be a String Bass folder but it will have Tuba and Baritone BC parts since no String Bass part is published. Directors may choose which part they want to use.

The following info shows split instrumentation parts and percussion requirements for each level:

## NC GRADE II BANDS (UIL LEVEL .5)

- No Split Parts
- Bells (1 player)
- Snare Drum/Bass Drum (2 players)
- Crash Cymbals (1 player)

## NC GRADE III BANDS (UIL LEVEL 1)

- 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> Clarinet
- 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> Trumpet
- Bells (1 player)
- Snare Drum/Bass Drum (2 players)
- Triangle/Crash Cymbals (1 or 2 players)
- Timpani (1 player) (2 Timpani needed)
