

FROM TIM HAMILTON:

Hello Directors,

This message is specifically for the following Directors:

1. Middle School Concert Band
2. High School (9-10) Band

The campus map found in the Final Information Packet emailed to you last evening didn't show the traffic route I need you to take when you arrive tomorrow morning. So I have shared these maps with you in a google file.

Middle School Concert Band

1. Enter campus from South Point Road.
2. When you've crossed the intersection of South Point Rd. and Nixon Rd. (1st traffic light), make *2nd right turn onto campus just across from the Chick-fil-A* (before the 2nd traffic light).
3. Then follow the *signs* which will lead you around our buildings. You will pass our mobile units, cafeteria, and auxiliary gym on the right as you go.
4. At the corner of the last building on the right, you will see a sign to round the curve to the right to continue along the same path towards the drop-off point.
5. Now, at the corner of the last building on the right, you will once again round the curve to the right to continue towards the drop-off point at our auditorium.
6. As you continue along this path you will round to the left and stop at the corner of a one-story brick storage building. There you will see the drop-off sign and release your kids there.
7. Then continue straight. Then turn left onto Nixon Road. Just at the start of the right curve, turn left into the Tennis Court parking lot. The space is kind of tight here, so if we have more than three buses, then we'll have to redirect you back towards the main campus to park parallel in front of the football stadium.

Now, you also need to be aware that we have a big playoff basketball game here tomorrow night. After returning from dinner, please enter the campus as directed above to the same drop-off location. Then turn left onto Nixon Road again, and this time make the next left onto the campus parking lot and try parking parallel in front of the football stadium, or otherwise do the best you can. This game wasn't originally scheduled as a home game, but apparently the school closings from last week altered things.

High School 9-10 Band

Your situation is much more feasible for Saturday morning.

Follow the same campus entrance route to the drop-off point as described above.

Then turn left onto Nixon Rd.

Make the next left onto the campus parking near the stadium and park wherever you want.

For Both Bands,

The attached maps should show the route in yellow, and applies to buses and cars.

However, no cars should park at the tennis court lot. There's only enough room for

about 3 buses there. Cars, hopefully no more than a few, need to find *unoccupied*

student spaces as best as you can. Faculty spaces are clearly marked and need to be

avoided. ***Everyone, please follow the maps that are shared with you***

from my google drive!

I'll also go ahead and also make you aware that my AP is still working to provide WiFi

Guest Access for you. GCS has very strict policies and doesn't make this very easy

here. We're doing our best, so please understand if this doesn't pan out for this

weekend! Remember, our kids haven't had this opportunity to be together and

rehearse and perform with their clinician since 2020. So let's keep everything in its

proper perspective. 😊
